## Tourism potential of the Republic of Karakalpakstan

Today, the Republic of Karakalpakstan – is a living link that links the past and the ancient past. 131 archaeological finds, 25 architectural samples, 89 monumental artistic monuments and about 40 attractions can be proved as a result.



At present, more than 40 tourist organizations operate in the Republic of Karakalpakstan, indicating the high tourist potential of the Republic of Karakalpakstan. Ayaz kala, Ayaz kala-2 and Ayaz kala-3 historical archaeological sites, about 18th century history dating back to the 18th century, well preserved their architecture and belonged to the 4th century AD The fortress and Sultan Uvays, including the grandfather, the late Father and the Daut-ata, contribute to the increase in the number of tourists visiting.

Every visitor to the Republic of Karakalpakstan, of course, entered the Karakalpak State Museum of Arts named I.V.Savitskiy and went on to see valuable exhibits there. The museum includes folk art, ancient and medieval Khorezm art, the Uzbek and Russian fine arts of the 1920s and 1920s, Karakalpak contemporary coloring and sculpture, scientific and educational departments of 1920s. More than 90,000 exhibits, such as jewelry, woodcarving, textile and national costumes dating back to the 30s, are now at the heart of tourists.



Modern hotel-run housekeeping is now in high demand, and modern services are being provided to local and foreign tourists, who have visited nearly 30 hotels and guest houses in the Republic of Karakalpakstan. In the first quarter of 2018, there are 7561

tourists serving, of which 942 are foreign tourists. It is a sign that tourism potential has been increased. Looking ahead to the transport industry, it takes only a few hours to reach the destination, not a few months. Today, tourist companies are equipped with special buses and minibuses. Tourist firms are using the option of arranging trips to the Aral Sea.



The Republic of Karakalpakstan is developing not only with its historical and legendary cities, but also ecotourism. Currently, the Republic of Karakalpakstan has 11,583 hectares of reserves. There are 826 heads of Bukhara deers in these reserves, 43 species of fish in the reservoirs, 11 species of reptiles and more than 10 species of foxes. The ostrich stored in the Bostan-straus farm in the village of Navoi in Ellikkala region, the Amir Timur Botanic Garden in the center of Ellikkala, carries out 200 tree saplings, 200 bushes and over 80 flowers growing in different parts of the world.
